


Cooccurrence Pointwise mutual information [Church and Hanks 1990]




HEAD-TO-HEAD (ANTI-CORRELATED, RARELY COOCCUR)











Immigration topics

- Cooccurrence: unimodal
- Prevelance correlation: unimodal
- Cooccurrence and prevalence correlation: positively correlated




prevalence correlation


JOINT DISTRIBUTIONS

ACL topics

- Cooccurrence: unimodal
- Prevelance correlation: complicated, not always unimodal
- Cooccurrence and prevalence correlation: positively correlated




RELATIONS BETWEEN IDEAS



THE STRENGTH OF RELATIONS

Strength = |PMI| × |correlation|

Extreme pairs are the interesting ones!



-1.0 -0.5 0.0 0.5 1.0 prevalence correlation





EVOLUTION OF IDEAS




OBAMA'S SPEECH ON DEATHS OF WARREN AND GIOVANNI




SENTIMENT EVOLUTION

- Subjectivity defined as the fraction of emotional words
- News articles are less subjective than sources, but shares and comments get more and more subjective



Red: more subjective 33
